EXECUTIVE ORDER  
ACCEPTING EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC ROAD ACROSS  
BUCKLEY AIR NATIONAL GUARD BASE

WHEREAS, on August 10, 1979 the United States granted to the City of Aurora, Colorado a road right-of-way easement across Buckley Air National Guard Base; and

WHEREAS, said easement, No. DACA45-2-79-6203 from the Department of the Air Force was for the purpose of improving Alameda Avenue; and

WHEREAS, said easement covers land situated in the SW ¼ of Section 15 Township 4 South, Range 66 West of the 6th principal meridian, Arapahoe County, Colorado, described as follows:

Beginning at the SW corner of Section 15, T4S, R66W of the 6th P.M., Arapahoe County, Colorado; thence N 00 degrees 29' 55" E, along the west line of the SW ¼ of said Section 15, a distance of 730.95 feet to a point on a curve; thence southeasterly along the arc of a curve to the right (whose chord bears S 06 degrees 08' 39" E a distance of 475.45 feet) having a radius of 2055.00 feet, a central angle of 13 degrees 17' 09", and an arc length of 476.52 feet to a point of tangent; thence S 00 degrees 29' 55" W along said tangent, parallel with and 55.00 feet distant from said west line, a distance of 258.69 feet to a point lying on the south line of the SW ¼ of said Section 15; thence westerly along said south line a distance of 55.00 feet to THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

And also,

The South 45.00 feet of the East 1245.00 feet of the West 1300.00 feet of the SW ¼ of Section 15, T4S, R66W of the 6th P.M., Arapahoe County, Colorado, containing in all (87,616 square feet) 2.0114 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado pursuant to title 10 U.S. Code section 2683 must accept exclusive legislative jurisdiction over said easement area while the United States retains proprietary interest;
