## EXECUTIVE ORDER

PROVIDING TEMPORARY SECURITY  
TO MR. AND MRS. JOHN W. HINCKLEY OF  
EVERGREEN, COLORADO

WHEREAS, due to the special circumstances surrounding the shooting of the President of the United States, it is deemed necessary and appropriate to furnish temporary security to Mr. and Mrs. John W. Hinckley of Evergreen, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, threats to the life and safety of Mr. and Mrs. Hinckley have been made within the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Harold Bray, Sheriff of Jefferson County, Colorado, and Art Dill, Chief of Police for the City and County of Denver, have requested assistance from the Colorado State Patrol in providing protection to Mr. and Mrs. Hinckley; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the protection of the family, preservation of the public peace, and the administration of justice that they be provided temporary security;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me by C.R.S. 1973, 43-5-113 (3), other statutes, and the Constitution of the State of Colorado, hereby authorize Ray Elder and Vic Beeby of the Colorado State Patrol Governor's Detail to assist other law enforcement agencies in providing security anywhere in the United States to Mr. and Mrs. John W. Hinckley and to provide such security directly when other law enforcement agencies are unable or unwilling to provide such security.

This Executive Order shall terminate on April 7, 1981, unless extended by a subsequent Executive Order.
