EXECUTIVE ORDER

IMPLEMENTING DISASTER EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION
FOR ADAMS AND WELD COUNTIES

WHEREAS, a state of disaster emergency exists in the State of Colorado in Adams and Weld Counties under my proclamation dated May 29, 1981; and

WHEREAS, strict compliance with regulatory statutes, rules, regulations or orders would prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with the emergency; and

WHEREAS, the suspension of said statutes, rules, or regulations or orders is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the general public; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to utilize all available resources of state government as are reasonably required to cope with the disaster emergency; and

WHEREAS, Horse Creek Dam on Horse Creek is in need of immediate repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under powers vested in me under C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104 and 28-2-502 (as amended) and all other enabling provisions, do hereby suspend the operation of statutes, rules, regulations and orders relating to loaning monies for the repair of Horse Creek Dam, and, in particular, C.R.S. 1973, 37-60-119, 121, 122, and 123, as amended, which relate to the water conservation board construction fund; and C.R.S. 1973, 24-30-202, as amended, together with all rules, regulations and orders promulgated thereunder which relate to fiscal procedures of execution of contracts by the State.

This Executive Order implements my proclamation dated May 29, 1981, and shall continue as long as my proclamation of May 29, 1981 is in full force and effect.
