EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

DISASTER EMERGENCY IN ADAMS AND WELD COUNTIES

WHEREAS, Horse Creek Dam on Horse Creek in Adams and Weld Counties is in imminent danger of breaching due to heavy rains and the age of the structure, and requires emergency repairs; and


WHEREAS, in the event of a breach in the dam, significant injury will occur to persons and property; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, do find that the aforesaid conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the people of the State of Colorado, and create a state of disaster emergency within the meaning of section 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104, and other enabling provisions, do hereby declare a state of disaster emergency in Adams and Weld Counties, and authorize all and that may be necessary under C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104. This proclamation shall expire after thirty (30) days unless further extended by me.
