## EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the State Council on Criminal Justice has been abolished through H.B. 1427, which I signed into law on May 18, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado still has certain responsibilities with respect to ongoing criminal justice programs; and


WHEREAS, the State of Colorado is in need of a mechanism for requesting and receiving any additional criminal justice program funds that may be available;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER the Division of Criminal Justice to perform the following duties in addition to those found in C.R.S., 1973, 24-32-503:

1. To review and approve rules and regulations, procedures and policies relating to applications for and distribution of funds made available to the state pursuant to the Justice System Improvement Act of 1979, including plans for assistance to local agencies and for distribution of funds.
2. To review and approve the state plans referred to in Section 24-32-503 (1) (b) and required under the Justice System Improvement Act of 1979, including plans for assistance to local agencies and for distribution of funds.
