EXECUTIVE ORDER

CALLING NATIONAL GUARD TO DUTY


WHEREAS, the forest fire in the vicinity of Poverty Mountain, Fremont County, Colorado, constitutes an imminent disaster threat to the loss of property and the safety, health, and welfare of the people of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, National Guard resources have been requested by the Forest Service, USDA, with compensation to be paid by that agency;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, direct that under the provisions of C.R.S. 1973, 28-3-104, the Adjutant General order to State Active Duty without pay, volunteer personnel of the Colorado National Guard to provide military support to the Forest Service, USDA, in essential fire suppression operation in Fremont County, Colorado.
