EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR GRASSHOPPER INFESTATION

WHEREAS, the 1981 invasion of grasshoppers has threatened the destruction of approximately 500,000 acres of Colorado range and grassland; and

WHEREAS, in response to said infestation, by Proclamation dated June 26, 1981, a state of disaster emergency was declared for counties to be specified by the Colorado Department of Agriculture; and

WHEREAS, said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the provisions of C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104, do hereby renew my Proclamation of June 26, 1981 for an additional thirty (30) days.
