EXECUTIVE ORDER

TERMINATING SPECIAL MOBILE HOME PARK PROJECT

WHEREAS, on April 28, 1980, I issued an Executive Order requesting the Attorney General of the State of Colorado to investigate and prosecute violations of the rights of Colorado residents of mobile home parks; and

WHEREAS, such investigation has resulted in significant amendments to the Colorado Mobile Home Park Landlord-Tenant Act, the development of model leases and park rules, formal proceedings and numerous informal agreements with mobile home parks requiring modifications of certain business practices; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has advised me that many goals of the project have been met and that it is no longer appropriate for this office to maintain this special effort;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. My Executive Order dated April 28, 1980, be rescinded, terminating the Special Mobile Home Park Project.
2. Reports of the project, particularly those summarizing further changes in state law, be forwarded to the General Assembly for their consideration.
