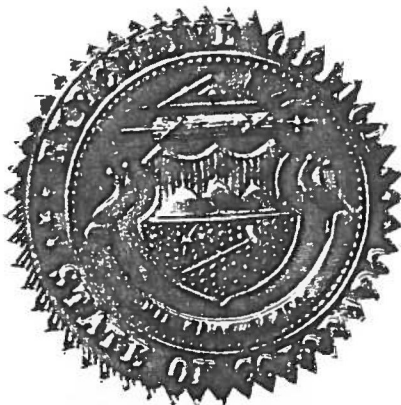

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION FOR ADAMS, DENVER, JEFFERSON AND WELD COUNTIES

- WHEREAS, on June 3, 1981, the Counties of Adams, Denver, Jefferson and Weld, in the State of Colorado, were hit by several tornadoes; and
- WHEREAS, said tornadoes resulted in significant injury to persons and property including the destruction of several private residences and businesses; and
- WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Adams, Denver, Jefferson and Weld Counties by Proclamation effective June 3, 1981; and
- WHEREAS, said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and
- WHEREAS, the Proclamation dated June 3, 1981 was extended on June 30, 1981, August 2, 1981, August 25, 1981, and September 30, 1981, for additional 30 day periods; and
- WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me in C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104, and other enabling provisions, DO HEREBY renew my proclamation of June 3, 1981 for an additional thirty (30) days.

GIVEN under my hand and the Executive Seal of the State of Colorado, this 30th day of October, 1981, effective October 30, 1981.
