EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

DISASTER EMERGENCY IN LARIMER COUNTY

WHEREAS, on July 15, 1982, severe damages from flood waters released by the Lawn Lake Reservoir occurred in Larimer County, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, said flood waters have caused substantial damage to public and private property; and

WHEREAS, immediate attention is required to protect public health, to reduce further damage, to ensure public safety, and to render emergency relief; and

WHEREAS, I, Nancy Dick, Acting Governor, do find that the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the public safety and welfare of the State and create a disaster emergency situation within the meaning of Section 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, under powers vested in me under Section 28-4-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, and other enabling provisions, I, Nancy Dick, Acting Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY DECLARE that a state of disaster emergency exists in Larimer County for the reasons set forth above, and that the aforementioned disaster area is entitled to aid, relief and assistance pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973.

THIS PROCLAMATION shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended by the Governor.
