## EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

### EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR GRASSHOPPER INFESTATION

WHEREAS, Colorado's farmers and ranchers contribute more than \$3 billion annually to the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS, this economy may be threatened by a serious infestation of grasshoppers; and

WHEREAS, such levels of infestation evidence continue to be a high risk potential for a serious grasshopper infestation during the 1982 growing season; and

WHEREAS, continuous action is required to determine the extent and magnitude of such infestation; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 28-2-104, C.R.S. 1973, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The state of disaster emergency declared in Executive Order D0003 82, dated May 19, 1982, and extended June 18, 1982, under Executive Order D0005 82, is hereby further extended so that aid, assistance and relief shall continue pursuant to the provisions of state law, for all counties in the State of Colorado except the following: Chaffee, Clear Creek, Denver, Gilpin, Grand, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Jackson, Lake, Mineral, Ouray, Pitkin, San Juan and Summit.
2. The Department of Agriculture is authorized to expend \$96,362 of cash funds available within the Department for this emergency.
