## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### REQUIRING STATE-OWNED MOTOR VEHICLES TO COMPLY WITH THE AUTOMOBILE INSPECTION AND READJUSTMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Automobile Inspection and Readjustment ("AIR") Program is to aid in attaining the National Ambient Air Quality Standards for carbon monoxide and photochemical oxidants in the Denver, Fort Collins, and Colorado Springs metropolitan areas as more fully specified in C.R.S. 1973, 42-4-307(7) (Supp. 1981) ("program area"); and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the "AIR" Program that all privately and publicly-owned motor vehicles as defined in C.R.S. 1973, 42-4-307(6) (Supp. 1981) of model years 1968 and later in the program area annually obtain a certification of emissions control in furtherance of that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the control of, and responsibility for, state-owned motor vehicles reside in individual departments and agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the power vested in me by Article IV of the Colorado Constitution, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

All directors of state departments and agencies owning motor vehicles of model years 1968 and later, which are based in the program area, shall ensure that such vehicles annually obtain a certification of emissions control and otherwise fully comply with the requirements of the "AIR" Program.
