EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION DISASTER EMERGENCY IN MONTROSE COUNTY

WHEREAS, unseasonably heavy rains during July of 1982 resulted in extensive flooding in Montrose County; and

WHEREAS, said flooding caused extensive damage to public and private property; and

WHEREAS, by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners dated July 29, 1982, Montrose County was declared to be a disaster area; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the state, and create an emergency disaster situation within the meaning of Section 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, under the powers vested in me in Section 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, and other enabling provisions, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY DECLARE Montrose County to be a disaster area, entitled to aid, relief and assistance.

This proclamation shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended.
