EXECUTIVE ORDER
PROCLAMATION
SUSPENDING STATUTES, RULES AND ORDERS FOR
DISASTER EMERGENCY IN MONTROSE COUNTY


- WHEREAS, an emergency disaster situation exists in the County of Montrose, State of Colorado, under proclamation dated August 18, 1982; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Montrose is in immediate need of funds to repair county roads, the disrepair of which constitutes a hazard to public health, safety and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, strict compliance with regulatory statutes, rules or orders would prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with the emergency; and
- WHEREAS, the suspension of said statutes, rules or orders is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to utilize all available resources of state government as are reasonably required to cope with the disaster emergency; and
- WHEREAS, the Division of Disaster Emergency Services has developed procedures for disbursing monies from the Disaster Emergency Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, to implement my proclamation of August 18, 1982, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under powers vested in me under C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104 and 28-2-502 of the Disaster Emergency Act and all other enabling provisions, do hereby suspend the operation of regulatory statutes, rules and regulations relating to the implementation of procedures developed by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services, and in particular C.R.S. 1973, 24-4-103, as amended; and further do hereby authorize the Division of Disaster Emergency Services to take any and all necessary actions, including the implementation of said procedures to provide financial assistance to the County of Montrose for the repair of roads on a 50/50 cost-sharing basis.
