EXECUTIVE ORDER

Colorado State Fair Promotion Fund

WHEREAS, in House Bill 1284, (the "long bill"), 1982 Colorado Session Laws Chapter 1 at page 10, the General Assembly appropriated \$200,000 to the Colorado State Fair Promotion Fund and stated that such monies were "to be utilized as 'seed money' by the State Fair Commission to promote fundraising activities to benefit the State Fair"; and

WHEREAS, the final authority and decision making in all matters related to the executive budget is vested in the Governor pursuant to Article IV of the Colorado Constitution and C.R.S. 1973, 24-37-406 (1981 Supp.); and

WHEREAS, efforts of the State Fair Commission in furtherance of the intent of "long bill" footnote (13) have thus far not been successful in raising additional funds for the operation of the Colorado State Fair;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to my authority under the Constitution and Statutes of Colorado do hereby order that:

1. Without my express approval, the State Fair Commission shall make no further expenditures from the Colorado State Fair Fund except for expenditures which have been obligated prior to today's date.
2. As soon as practicable, the Commissioner of Agriculture shall review the balance remaining in the Colorado State Fair Fund and shall recommend to me the appropriate use of these funds to accomplish the ongoing activities of the State Fair.
