EXECUTIVE ORDER

COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO ADMINISTER LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Public Law 97-35 included provisions for a program of benefits to low-income individuals and families to provide assistance in coping with rising home heating costs; and

WHEREAS, the provision of such assistance, referred to as the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program, is designed to aid those who receive payments under State Public Assistance programs such as Aid to Families with Dependent Children, Food Assistance and other programs, together with other individuals whose income is within the limits described in relation to the poverty level; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Social Services is authorized under Colorado Revised Statutes, 1973, 26-1-109 and 111, to accept and supervise such programs and is experienced in the necessary administrative practices; and

WHEREAS, it is the objective of this Administration to provide assistance benefits equitably and efficiently to the various groups of eligible recipients, utilizing all available resources and avoiding duplication of benefits thereto; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the low-income segment of the Colorado population to distribute the benefits which are available under the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program as expeditiously and efficiently as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby ORDER THAT:

1. The Colorado Department of Social Services is designated as the responsible agency to administer the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program in accordance with applicable provisions of state and federal laws and regulations. The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program shall consist of two parts: (1) a Basic Low-Income Energy Assistance Program and (2) an Emergency Home Heating Program.
