EXECUTIVE ORDER
PROCLAMATION
EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN MONTROSE COUNTY

WHEREAS, unseasonably heavy rains during July of 1982 resulted in extensive flooding in Montrose County; and

WHEREAS, said flooding caused extensive damage to public and private property; and


WHEREAS, by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners dated July 29, 1982, Montrose County was declared to be a disaster area; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 1973, 28-2-104;

NOW, THEREFORE, under the powers vested in me in Section 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, and other enabling provisions, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, **DO HEREBY** renew my proclamation of August 18, 1982. This proclamation shall expire on January 31, 1983, unless otherwise extended.
