EXECUTIVE ORDER

OFFICE OF RURAL JOB TRAINING

- WHEREAS, since February 22, 1979, under Executive Order D000579, the office called "BOS/CETA Prime Sponsor" under the Department of Labor and Employment, Office of the Executive Director, was made the agent for purposes of administering and carrying out all necessary planning and the delivery of services under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, as amended, for the balance of state; and
- WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, as amended, expires September 30, 1983; and
- WHEREAS, BOS/CETA Prime Sponsor has been designated as the gramt recipient and program administrator for the forty-five (45) county rural service delivery area for the Job Training Partnership Act by the Rural Colorado Private Industry Council and chief local elected officials; and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of this office to change the name "BOS/CETA Prime Sponsor" to the "Office of Rural Job Training", to more closely identify with the rural service delivery area and the new Job Training Partnership Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

- The new name for "BOS/CETA Prime Sponsor" will be the "Office of Rural Job Training".
- The functional responsibilities will remain the same under the Department of Labor and Employment, Office of the Executive Director.

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- 3. The purpose of the Office of Rural Job Training shall be "to provide job training and employment opportunities for economically disadvantaged, unemployed, or underemployed persons which shall result in an increase in their earned income, and to assure that training and other services lead to maximum employment opportunities and enhance self-sufficiency" as set forth in the Job Training Partnership Act for the forty-five (45) county rural service delivery area.
- 4. The Office of Rural Job Training shall be, in addition, responsible for the coordination between local elected officials and the Rural Colorado Private Industry Council in executing the Job Training Partnership Act as the agent for both entities.
