EXECUTIVE ORDER

SUSPENDING STATUTES, RULES AND ORDERS FOR IMMINENT EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER ASSISTANCE FOR CLEAR CREEK COUNTY

- WHEREAS, an imminent emergency situation exists in the State of Colorado, under Executive Order D0018 83, dated June 20, 1983; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Clear Creek is in immediate need of assistance and resources from state and federal agencies to stop the threat of flooding or the consequences of flooding; and
- WHEREAS, immediate attention is required to protect against the threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from the threat of floods; and
- WHEREAS, strict compliance with regulatory statutes, rules or orders would prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with the threat of flooding and the suspension of said statutes, rules or orders is necessary for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, the Division of Disaster Emergency Services has developed procedures for disbursing monies from the Disaster Emergency Fund and assisting areas with other state resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, to implement my Executive Order of June 20, 1983, pursuant to the powers vested in me under C.R.S. 1973, Section 28-2-104 and 28-2-502 of the Disaster Emergency Act, as amended, and all other enabling provisions, do hereby suspend the operation of regulatory statutes, rules and regulations relating to the implementation of procedures developed by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services for use of the State Disaster Emergency Fund and, in particular, C.R.S. 1973, as amended; and further DO HEREBY ORDER:

1. The Division of Disaster Emergency Services to implement the Guidelines for Administration of the State Disaster Emergency Fund developed by the Division.

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- 2. The Division of Disaster Emergency Services activate the State National Guard Disaster Emergency Operations Plan and request technical advice and assistance from the Corps of Engineers.
- 3. The Colorado Department of Highways assist Clear Creek County with state financial and physical resources.

This Executive Order shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended.
