## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### RESTRICTION OF APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, state government today embarks on fiscal year 1983-84, facing uncertain prospects concerning General Fund revenues; and

WHEREAS, current estimates do not project sufficient General Fund revenues in fiscal year 1983-84 to fully fund appropriations and the required 4 percent reserve; and

WHEREAS, Section 24-30-206(3), C.R.S. 1973 (1982 Replacement Volume) provides for the controller, upon approval of the Governor, to set aside a reserve from the appropriations of the various departments, institutions and agencies of state government in order to meet emergencies that may arise during the fiscal year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The State Controller restrict 2 percent of each department's General Fund appropriation and place these funds in a restricted reserve account; and
2. The above restriction shall remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent Executive Order.
