EXECUTIVE ORDER

TERMINATION OF VEHICLE MILEAGE QUARTERLY REPORTS

WHEREAS, on May 18, 1979, I issued Executive Order #DO011 79, which directed each executive department to reduce by 5 percent the mileage driven by employees on official business; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 1982, I reaffirmed the intent of that Executive Order; and

WHEREAS, the executive departments complied with the intent of the Executive Order; and


WHEREAS, the General Assembly, by passing Senate Bill 401 (1983 Session), made an initial step toward centralizing vehicle management which provides more practical controls of vehicle utilization without the necessity of separate quarterly reports to the Department of Administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER:

1. The intent of Executive Order #DO011 79 has been complied with by executive departments.
2. The initial step toward centralizing vehicle management has been taken by the General Assembly and this system will provide some practical controls of vehicle usage without the necessity of separate quarterly reports to the Department of Administration.
3. Executive Order #DO011 79 is withdrawn effective immediately.
