EXECUTIVE ORDER

SUSPENSION OF THE ISSUANCE OF WARNING TICKETS BY THE COLORADO STATE PATROL FOR SPEED VIOLATIONS ABOVE THE 55 MPH LIMIT IS REPEALED AND THE EXECUTIVE ORDER OF MAY 23, 1979, IS SUPERSEDED

WHEREAS, the availability of petroleum products which are vital to public safety, welfare and commerce, continues to be a serious problem facing our state; and


WHEREAS, members of the motoring public continue to waste precious energy resources by driving at speeds in excess of the 55 mile-per-hour National Maximum Speed Limit; and

WHEREAS, increasing the enforcement arsenal of the Colorado State Patrol will be a step toward achieving better compliance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY DIRECT the Colorado State Patrol, commencing immediately, to resume the issuance of warning tickets for speed violations above the 55 mile-per-hour limit. I further direct the Colorado State Patrol to use these warning tickets as an additional, rather than a replacement, enforcement tool. To the extent that this Order is in conflict with the Executive Order of May 23, 1979, that Order is hereby superseded.
