EXECUTIVE ORDER

Use of Safety Restraint Systems in State-Owned Vehicles

WHEREAS, the Association of State and Territorial Health Officers has passed a resolution encouraging the issuance of an executive order requiring government employees and passengers in government-owned vehicles to use safety restraint systems; and


WHEREAS, motor vehicle accidents are a major cause of death and disability among both adults and children; and

WHEREAS, the incidence of such death and disability can be greatly decreased by the use of proper safety restraint systems in vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it behooves all state employees to protect themselves and others in government-owned vehicles against such deaths and disabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER that all state employees and passengers in state-owned vehicles use safety restraint systems provided whenever the vehicles are in motion.
