EXECUTIVE ORDER

Restriction of Appropriation

WHEREAS, current revenue estimates do not project sufficient General Fund revenues in fiscal year 1983-84 to fund appropriations fully and provide for a sufficient reserve; and

WHEREAS, Section 24-30-206 (3), CRS 1973 (1982 Replacement Volume) provides for the controller, upon approval of the Governor, to set aside a reserve from the appropriations of the various departments, institutions and agencies of the state government;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The State Controller restrict 1 percent of half of each department's General Fund appropriation, net of October supplementals, and place these funds in a restricted reserve account; and
2. The above restriction shall remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent Executive Order.
