EXECUTIVE ORDER

ESTABLISHING A SECURITY SUBUNIT WITHIN THE STATE LOTTERY DIVISION

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 24-35-204 (3) (m) and C.R.S. 24-35-208 (1) (c), the State Lottery Division is required to protect the security and integrity of the lottery games; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 24-35-205 (3), in order to protect all lottery games, employees of the State Lottery Division have peace officer status during the period of any investigation of organization, bidders, contractors, licensees, license applicants and other persons or entities; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the above-stated purposes in an efficient and economical manner, it is necessary to establish a specified security subunit within the State Lottery Division, the principal purpose of which shall be the administration of criminal justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by the power vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby establish a security subunit within the State Lottery Division, the principal purpose of which shall be the administration of criminal justice as defined by 28 C.F.R. 20.3 (c) (2) and (d) and which shall be designated as the Lottery security subunit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a substantial proportion of any money appropriated for the security subunit shall be allocated to the administration of criminal justice.
