## EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

### DISASTER EMERGENCY IN GUNNISON COUNTY

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Gunnison County since May 22, 1984; and

WHEREAS, said flooding has resulted in significant damage to public and private property in Gunnison County; and

WHEREAS, the threat of additional flooding exists in Gunnison County; and

WHEREAS, immediate assistance is required to protect public health, to reduce further damage, to ensure public safety, and to render emergency relief;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under Section 28-2-104 of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, DO HEREBY DECLARE that a state of emergency exists in Gunnison County, for the reasons set forth above, and that the aforementioned area within the state are entitled to aide, relief and assistance, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1973, and as may be available under the provisions of federal law.

This Executive Order shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended.
