EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

DISASTER EMERGENCY IN DOLORES, HINSDALE AND SAGUACHE COUNTIES

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Dolores, Hinsdale and Saguache Counties in the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, said flooding has resulted in significant damage to public and private property in Dolores, Hinsdale and Saguache Counties; and

WHEREAS, the threat of additional flooding exists in Dolores, Hinsdale and Saguache Counties; and

WHEREAS, immediate assistance is required to protect public health, to reduce further damage, to ensure public safety, and to render emergency relief.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under Section 24-33.5-704, DO HEREBY DECLARE that a state of emergency exists in Dolores, Hinsdale and Saguache Counties of Colorado, for the reasons set forth above, and that the aforementioned areas within the state are entitled to aid, relief and assistance, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, and as may be available under the provisions of federal law.

This Executive Order shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended.
