EXECUTIVE ORDER
PROCLAMATION

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN GUNNISON COUNTY

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Gunnison County since May 22, 1984; and


WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Gunnison County, Colorado, by Proclamation dated May 25, 1984, and extended by executive orders dated June 27, 1984, July 25, 1984, August 27, 1984, and September 24, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 24-33.5-704;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under Section 24-33.5-704, and other enabling provisions, DO HEREBY renew my proclamation of September 24, 1984 for an additional thirty (30) days.
