EXECUTIVE ORDER

IMPLEMENTING DISASTER EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION FOR DOLORES COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF DOVE CREEK

WHEREAS, a disaster emergency exists in Dolores County and the Town of Dove Creek under proclamation dated October 25, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Dolores County on August 20, 1984, and the Mayor of the Town of Dove Creek on August 21, 1984, declared that a state of emergency existed in the county and town; and

WHEREAS, Dolores County and the Town of Dove Creek have requested state financial assistance for emergency response and repairs; and

WHEREAS, strict compliance with regulatory statutes, rules, regulations or orders would prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in providing financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the suspension of said statutes, rules, regulations or orders is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Disaster Emergency Services has developed procedures for disbursing monies from the Disaster Emergency Fund for said repairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, direct the Division of Disaster Emergency Services assisted by state departments and agencies it designates, to provide state financial assistance to Dolores County and the Town of Dove Creek utilizing the Guidelines for Administration of the State Disaster Emergency Fund developed by the division.

FURTHER, to implement this Executive Order, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the power vested in me under C.R.S. 24-33.5-704 and 24-33.5-1102 of the Disaster Emergency Act, as amended, and all other enabling provisions, do hereby suspend the operation of regulatory statutes, rules and regulations relating to the implementation of procedures developed by the division for use of the State Disaster Emergency Fund and, in particular, C.R.S. 24-4-103, as amended, and further do hereby
