## EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION DISASTER EMERGENCY IN CONEJOS COUNTY

WHEREAS, a severe winter storm caused dangerous conditions to exist in Conejos County in the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, said dangerous conditions stranded motorists and hunters, and isolated large herds of cattle and sheep; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Conejos County on October 17, 1984, declared that a state of emergency existed in Conejos County; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Conejos County on October 21, 1984, requested state assistance for the emergency cattle feeding operation; and

WHEREAS, immediate assistance is required to protect public health, to reduce further damage, to ensure public safety, and to render emergency relief;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under Section 24-33.5-704, DO HEREBY DECLARE that a state of emergency exists in Conejos County of Colorado, for the reasons set forth above, and that the aforementioned area within the state is entitled to aide, relief and assistance, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, and as may be available under the provisions of federal law.

This Executive Order shall expire after thirty (30) days, unless otherwise extended.
