## EXECUTIVE ORDER

CONTINUING SUSPENSION COMPLIANCE WITH STATUTES AND RULES DURING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN THE TOWN OF OAK CREEK, ROUTT COUNTY

- WHEREAS, an emergency disaster exists in the State of Colorado under proclamations dated May 23, 1984, June 27, 1984, August 27, 1984, September 24, 1984, October 24, 1984, November 23, 1984, December 24, 1984, and January 30, 1985; and
- WHEREAS, strict compliance with regulatory statutes, rules, regulations or orders would prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with the emergency; and
- WHEREAS, the suspension of said statutes, rules, regulations or orders is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the general public; and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to utilize all available resources of State government as are reasonably required to cope with the disaster emergency; and
- WHEREAS, domestic water system facilities including but not limited to head gate division structures, pipeline and water supply reservoir belonging to the Town of Oak Creek in Routt County are in immediate need of repair; and
- WHEREAS, the Division of Disaster Emergency Services has developed procedures for disbursing monies from the Disaster Emergency fund for said repairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, to implement my proclamations of May 23, 1984, June 27, 1984, August 27, 1984, September 24, 1984, October 24, 1984, November 23, 1984, December 24, 1984, and January 30, 1985, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under powers vested in me under C.R.S. 24-33.5-704 and 24-33.5-1102 of the Disaster Emergency Act and all other enabling provisions, do hereby continue the suspension of the operation of regulatory statutes, rules, regulations and orders relating to the implementation of procedures developed by the Division of Disaster Emergency Services for disbursing monies for repairs to the damaged public facility located in the above-stated county and, in particular, C.R.S. 37-60-119 through 122, as amended, which relate to the water conservation board construction fund; and C.R.S. 24-30-202, as amended, together with all rules, regulations and orders promulgated

thereunder which relate to fiscal procedures for execution of contracts by the State; and

FURTHER, I do hereby authorize the Division of Disaster Emergency Services to take any and all necessary action, including the implementation of said procedures, to provide financial assistance for the purposes stated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY renew my executive order of December 24, 1984 for an additional thirty (30) days.
