EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN DOLORES, HINSDALE AND SAGUACHE COUNTIES

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Dolores, Hinsdale and Saguache Counties in the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Dolores, Hinsdale and Saguache Counties under Proclamations dated September 21, 1984, October 22, 1984, November 21, 1984, December 21, 1984, and January 21, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 24-33.5-704;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under Section 24-33.5-704, DO HEREBY renew my proclamation of January 21, 1985 for an additional thirty (30) days.
