E X E C U T I V E O R D E R CONTINUING DESIGNATION OF SERVICE DELIVERY AREAS UNDER THE JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT

- WHEREAS, subject to the requirements of the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982 (Public Law 97-300, Section 101), the Governor must designate sub-state service delivery areas (SDAs); and

 - E. El Paso County and the City of Colorado Springs as a consortium;

- 2. All Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) service delivery areas (SDAs) originally designated in Executive Order D0010 83, dated April 1, 1983, shall continue to be effective until July 1, 1987 unless modified by Executive Order.
