EXECUTIVE ORDER
DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS UNDER THE
FURTHER CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 1983

WHEREAS, the United States Congress enacted on December 20, 1983, Section 155 of the Further Continuing Appropriations Act of 1983, Public Law No. 97-377, which distributes funds collected by the United States Department of Energy as the result of oil pricing settlements to the states, territories and possessions of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Colorado received \$2,063,200 under the distribution formula prescribed by Congress; and

WHEREAS, Section 155 of the Further Continuing Appropriations Act of 1983, Public Law No. 97-377, provides that these funds may be used in five federal energy conservation programs; and

WHEREAS, Section 155 of the Further Continuing Appropriations Act of 1983, Public Law No. 97-377, provides for these funds to be distributed to the governor or chief executive officer of the states, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, and the territories and possessions of the United States; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the governor or chief executive officer to distribute these funds in a manner that will benefit those who may have been injured by overcharges for the purchase of petroleum products; and

WHEREAS, an original allocation made in the executive order dated April 15, 1983, has not been spent in as timely a fashion as originally envisioned;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to Section 155 of the Further Continuing Appropriations Act of 1983, Public Law No. 97-377, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The remainder of the \$383,535 originally allocated to the Low-Cost Weatherization Program is hereby re-allocated as follows:



\$155,500 is to be distributed to the Office of Energy Conservation for programs operated under the Energy Extension Service under the National Energy Extension Service Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 7001 et seq.; and

\$218,894 is to be distributed to the Office of Energy Conservation for purposes of the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (relating to primary and supplemental state energy conservation programs), 42 U.S.C., §§ 6321 et seq.
