EXECUTIVE ORDER

Richard D. Lamm
Governor

REQUIRING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF COLORADO TO APPEAR FOR THE STATE AND PROSECUTE A CRIMINAL ACTION AND PROCEEDING

WHEREAS, certain matters have come to the attention of the Governor of the State of Colorado which relate to the conduct of certain persons who were connected with the Governor's Job Training Office; and,

WHEREAS, the office of Governor of the State of Colorado has referred to the Attorney General for the purpose of evaluating certain reports and information that relate to the above-described conduct; and,


WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General has become familiar with the alleged conduct of certain former officials of the Governor's Job Training Office; and,

WHEREAS, the Attorney General is of the opinion that grounds exist for the filing of criminal charges against Eugene Kane and James Moore arising from their involvement with the Governor's Job Training Office; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 24-31-101 (1)(a) there is a statutory basis for requiring the Attorney General of the State of Colorado to prosecute certain causes at the direction of the Governor of the State of Colorado;

NOW THEREFORE, under and pursuant to authority vested in me by section 24-31-101(1)(a) C.R.S. (1982 Repl. Vol.), I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby require the Attorney General of the State of Colorado to investigate and prosecute Eugene Kane and James Moore and, for such purposes, hereby invest the Attorney General with the necessary criminal authority under said subsection 101(1)(a).
