EXECUTIVE ORDER

COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE

OLAN POOLER, DOC 101000896, was sentenced from Adams County and received at Colorado State Penitentiary May 10, 1983, to serve 10 years for the crime of 1st Degree Assault (82 CR 0220).

After review of his case and after mature deliberation, it has been decided to extend executive clemency for the following reasons:

1. The Certificate of Conduct states that OLAN POOLER, DOC 101000896, has maintained good behavior and recommends him for favorable consideration;
2. It is the recommendation of the medical physicians of the Department of Corrections that the sentence of OLAN POOLER, DOC 101000896, be commuted;
3. It is deemed that the interests of all concerned will be best served by a commutation of sentence.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

That the sentence of OLAN POOLER, DOC 101000896, be commuted to time served in order to effectuate immediate parole eligibility. The Department of Corrections may consider other factors authorized by law in addition to this commute in determining the final parole eligibility date.
