EXECUTIVE ORDER

STATE GROUNDWATER PROTECTION GOAL

Richard D. Lamm Governor

- WHEREAS, groundwater is a valuable natural resource of the State of Colorado; and
- WHEREAS, groundwater and surface water are important state waters which are often interrelated; and
- WHEREAS, the economic growth and vitality of the State is dependent upon having ample sources of high quality water for domestic, agricultural, industrial and recreational uses; and
- WHEREAS, there is frequently a relationship between the quality of groundwater and its allocation and use; and
- WHEREAS, groundwater is used as a source of water for public water supplies in a large percentage of systems in the State; and
- WHEREAS, contaminated groundwater is technologically difficult and extremely expensive to purify; and
- WHEREAS, there are several state agencies with numerous statutory responsibilities which are being utilized to protect groundwater; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need for coordination among these State agencies in order to avoid regulatory and investigative duplication and conflict: and
- WHEREAS, the Colorado Water Quality Control Commission is a principal entity of State government charged with adopting regulations and standards necessary to assure the quality of state waters; and
- WHEREAS, the Colorado Water Quality Control Commission has adopted a Groundwater Protection Goal which is consistent with the goal stated in item I herein.
- NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Statutes and Constitution of the State of Colorado, do hereby order that:
 - I. The State of Colorado will use the following as the State Groundwater Protection Goal for preserving the quality of our valuable groundwater resources:

"THE GOAL OF THE STATE OF COLORADO IS TO PROVIDE MAXIMUM BENEFICIAL USE OF GROUNDWATER RESOURCES WHILE ASSURING SAFETY OF THE USERS BY PREVENTING OR CONTROLLING THOSE ACTIVITIES WHICH HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO IMPAIR EXISTING OR FUTURE BENEFICIAL USES OF GROUNDWATER OR TO ADVERSELY AFFECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH."

- All State agencies should strive to achieve the State's Groundwater Protection Goal to the extent that resources and their respective statutory authorities allow.
- III. The Colorado Department of Health is given the primary responsibility for coordinating groundwater protection efforts within the Executive Branch of this state's government, and all State agencies should coordinate such efforts with the Department of Health.
- IV. In facilitate coordination order to of groundwater protection efforts, a "Memorandum of Agreement Between Colorado Agencies for the Protection of the Quality of Groundwater Resources of the State" executed by the following state agencies, boards, and commissions will govern their groundwater protection efforts:
