## EXECUTIVE ORDER

### PARTIAL REVISION OF DISTRIBUTION OF STANDARD OIL COMPANY (INDIANA) AND BELRIDGE OIL COMPANY OIL OVERCHARGE REFUNDS

WHEREAS, the Department of Energy entered into consent decrees with Standard Oil Company (Indiana) and Belridge Oil Company which provided that states will be permitted to submit plans for the use of these funds; and

WHEREAS, Colorado's allocation of the Standard Oil Company (Indiana) consent decree is \$387,135; and

WHEREAS, Colorado's allocation of the Belridge Oil Company consent decree is \$1,254; and

WHEREAS, an Executive Order dated March 12, 1984 allocated \$60,000 of the funds received from the Standard Oil and Belridge consent decrees to energy conservation projects related to improved energy efficiency in schools; and

WHEREAS, that Executive Order also authorized the Governor's Job Training Office to administer such funds, but the Colorado Office of Energy Conservation now appears to be best suited to perform this function;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the consent decrees mentioned above, do hereby order that \$60,000 is to be used for energy conservation projects related to improved energy efficiency in schools, as defined in the State Energy Conservation Program. This money will be distributed to the Office of Energy Conservation.
