EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

DISASTER EMERGENCY IN MESA, MINERAL AND TELLER COUNTIES

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Alamosa, Garfield and Rio Grande Counties in the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Alamosa, Garfield and Rio Grande Counties by Proclamation dated June 28, 1985, and extended by Executive Orders dated July 29, 1985, and August 27, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned proclamation was extended until August 26, 1985 by a Proclamation dated July 29, 1985; and

WHEREAS, it is now apparent that flooding which resulted from the same spring snowmelt conditions has affected Mesa, Mineral, and Teller Counties severely.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under C.R.S. 24-33.5-704, DO HEREBY amend my Proclamation of June 28, 1985, to declare a state of disaster emergency to be in effect for Mesa, Mineral, and Teller Counties, as well.

Given under my hand and the Executive Seal of the State of Colorado, this 16th day of October, A.D. 1985 nunc pro tunc to September 26, 1985.
