E X E C U T I V E O R D E R

TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO THE OFFICE OF ENERGY CONSERVATION

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services is the recipient of funds under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 (P.L. 97-35); hereafter referred to as the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP); and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Social Services is the recipient of funds for the LIEAP Program; and

WHEREAS, the Low-Income Energy Assistance Act of 1981 allows up to fifteen (15) percent of the funds to be used for low-cost residential weatherization or other energy-related home repair for low-income households; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the provision of low-cost residential weatherization services will provide long-range benefits for Colorado's low-income population; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Energy Conservation and the Colorado Department of Local Affairs have experience in providing low-cost weatherization services to low-income populations; and

WHEREAS, the division of weatherization funds between these two agencies best serves Colorado's low-income population.

EXECUTIVE ORDER

TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO THE OFFICE OF ENERGY CONSERVATION

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby ORDER THAT:

1. The Office of Energy Conservation and the Colorado Department of Local Affairs are designated as the responsible agencies to administer a low-cost weatherization program.
2. The Low-Cost Weatherization Program shall be administered in accordance with all federal laws and regulations.
3. The Department of Local Affairs shall receive from the Colorado Department of Social Services \$4,444,446.00 for LIEAP weatherization program costs and \$309,400.00 for administrative costs.
4. As soon as possible thereafter, the Department of Local Affairs will transfer to the Office of Energy Conservation \$2,376,923.00 for weatherization programs and \$117,700.00 for administrative purposes.
