EXECUTIVE ORDER

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN MOFFAT, RIO BLANCO, SAN MIGUEL, OURAY, EAGLE AND PITKIN COUNTIES

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Moffat, Rio Blanco, San Miguel, Ouray, Eagle and Pitkin Counties in Colorado since July 13, 1984; and

WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Moffat, Rio Blanco, San Miguel, Ouray, Eagle and Pitkin Counties in Colorado by Proclamation dated July 13, 1984, and extended by Executive Orders dated August 27, 1984, nunc pro tunc to August 13, 1984, September 13, 1984, October 15, 1984, November 14, 1984, December 14, 1984, January 14, 1985, February 11, 1985, March 13, 1985, April 16, 1985, May 13, 1985, July 29, 1985, nunc pro tunc to June 12, 1985, July 29, 1985, nunc pro tunc to July 12, 1985, August 9, 1985, and October 16, 1985 nunc pro tunc to September 8, 1985; December 3, 1985 nunc pro tunc to November 7, 1985, January 14, 1986, nunc pro tunc to December 7, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 24-33.5-704;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under C.R.S. 24-33.5-704, and other enabling provisions, DO HEREBY renew my proclamation of July 13, 1984 for an additional thirty (30) days.
