EXECUTIVE ORDER

ADDITIONAL DISTRIBUTION OF STANDARD OIL COMPANY (INDIANA) AND BELRIDGE OIL COMPANY OIL OVERCHARGE REFUNDS

WHEREAS, the Department of Energy entered into consent decrees with Standard Oil Company (Indiana) and Belridge Oil Company, which provided that states will be permitted to submit plans for the use of these funds; and

WHEREAS, Colorado's allocation of the Standard Oil Company (Indiana) consent decree is \$387,135; and

WHEREAS, Colorado's allocation of the Belridge Oil Company consent decree is \$1,254; and

WHEREAS, Colorado's original plan for the use of \$65,000 of this amount was not approved by the Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy; and

WHEREAS, Colorado submitted a plan to the Office of Hearings and Appeals proposing to use the \$65,000 for the current Clean Air Campaign; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Hearings and Appeals approved the use of these funds for that purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the consent decrees and orders mentioned above, do hereby order that the \$65,000 be transferred to the Governor's Office from the Office of Energy Conservation, Department of Regulatory Agencies, so that the funds are used as approved by the Office of Hearings and Appeals.
