## EXECUTIVE ORDER

AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF CONFLICT COUNSEL IN LITIGATION INVOLVING THE COLORADO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

WHEREAS,	the Public Utilities Commission is engaged in a lawsuit entitled Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel v. Colorado Public Utilities Commission, Mountain States Telephone & Telegraph Company, and AT&T Communications of the Mountain States; and
WHEREAS,	the complainant, Office of Consumer Counsel (OCC), is challenging the legality of certain rules and regulations adopted by the Public Utilities Commission (PUC); and
WHEREAS,	the Office of the Attorney General of Colorado, prior to the filing of such lawsuit, indicated by letter to the PUC that the Attorney General felt that said rules and regulations were invalidly adopted; and
WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has determined that it is unable to defend the PUC in the above-named lawsuit in light of its legal opinion opposing the PUC's position on this issue; and
WHEREAS,	the Governor is authorized, pursuant to C.R.S. 24-31-101(e), to permit an agency of the executive branch of state government to employ counsel in the event that the Governor finds that "the attorney

general is unable or has failed or refused to provide legal services to an agency of state government;"

## E X E C U T I V E O R D E R AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF CONFLICT COULSEL IN LITIGATION INVOLVING THE COLORADO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

NOW THEREFORE, under and pursuant to the authority vested in me by C.R.S. 24-31-101, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY FIND AND ORDER, that:

- 1. The Attorney General has refused to provide legal services to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission in the litigation described above, and therefore the Public Utilities Commission may employ counsel of its own choosing to provide legal services in connection with said litigation.
- 2. Expenses incurred because of the employment of counsel by the Public Utilities Commission in this matter represent a lawful charge against the appropriations made by the General Assembly to the Department of Law.
