EXECUTIVE ORDER PROCLAMATION

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN ALAMOSA, GARFIELD, RIO GRANDE MESA, MINERAL, AND TELLER COUNTIES

WHEREAS, spring snowmelt has caused flooding conditions to exist in Alamosa, Garfield, Rio Grande, Mesa, Mineral, and Teller Counties in the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Alamosa, Garfield and Rio Grande Counties by Proclamation dated June 28, 1985, and extended by Executive Order dated July 29, 1985 and amended on August 23, 1985 to include Mesa, Mineral and Teller Counties and extended by Executive Order dated July 29, 1985; August 27, 1985; October 16, 1985; nunc pro tunc to September 26, 1985; October 20, 1985; December 3, 1985 nunc pro tunc to November 26, 1985, January 14, 1986 nunc pro tunc to December 26, 1985; January 25, 1986; February 26, 1986; March 26, 1986; April 25, 1986; and


WHEREAS, the said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 24-33.5-704;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under C.R.S. 24-33.5-704, DO HEREBY renew my Proclamation of June 28, 1985, as amended, for an additional thirty (30) days.
