EXECUTIVE ORDER

INVALID OVERRIDE OF LONG BILL VETOES

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 12 of the Colorado Constitution requires the General Assembly to reconsider each item veto separately, and


WHEREAS, the Colorado House of Representatives on May 27, 1986, voted to override my Long Bill item vetoes in one single recorded vote, and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has advised me that the procedure followed by the House of Representatives failed to satisfy the constitutional requirement and that the failure to pass the override allows the vetoes to stand, and

WHEREAS, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, state agencies require direction regarding the nature and conditions of the appropriations available to them,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, do hereby direct that the State Controller and the various departments and agencies affected by these vetoes act as though the vetoes stand and that the vetoed items are void.
