EXECUTIVE ORDER

COMPLIANCE WITH LONG BILL FOOTNOTES

WHEREAS, recent court decisions have determined that footnotes in the Appropriations Act are non-binding statements of legislative intent and have no legal effect, and


WHEREAS, some of these statements of legislative intent would accomplish the proper administration of the budget and some of them would not, and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Executive Branch to ensure the proper administration of the State budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, do hereby direct that state agencies submit to me, through the Office of State Planning and Budgeting, all requests for compliance with, or noncompliance with the footnotes in the Appropriations Act for fiscal year 1986-87.

FURTHER, all decisions on compliance or noncompliance with said footnotes will be made by me and such decisions will be binding on all state agencies.
