EXECUTIVE ORDER

PROCLAMATION

EXTENDING DISASTER EMERGENCY IN DELTA COUNTY

WHEREAS, an earth slide occurred on June 16, 1986 in Delta County and destroyed twelve hundred feet of irrigation ditch belonging to the Stewart Ditch Company, and

WHEREAS in response to the aforesaid conditions, a state of disaster emergency was declared to exist in Delta County by Proclamation dated August 8, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the said state of disaster emergency expires after thirty (30) days unless otherwise extended by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor, do find that the aforementioned state of disaster emergency has not been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist within the meaning of C.R.S. 24-33.5-704;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, under the powers vested in me under C.R.S. 24-33.5-704, DO HEREBY renew my Proclamation of August 8, 1986, as amended, for an additional thirty (30) days.
