EXECUTIVE ORDER

RESTRICTION OF APPROPRIATION

WHEREAS, Current revenue estimates excluding the impact of federal tax reform do not project sufficient General Fund revenues in fiscal year 1986-87 to fund appropriations fully and provide for a sufficient reserve; and

WHEREAS, Section 24-30-206 (3), C.R.S., provides for the controller, upon approval of the Governor, to set aside a reserve from the appropriations of the various departments, institutions and agencies of the state government;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to authority vested in me under the statutes and constitution of the State of Colorado, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The State Controller restrict two percent of each department's General Fund appropriation, and place these funds in a restricted reserve account; and
2. The above restriction shall remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent Executive Order.
