EXECUTIVE ORDER

ADDENDUM TO EXECUTIVE ORDER D0121-86 CONCERNING TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services is the recipient of funds under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 (P.L. 97-35); hereafter referred to as the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP); and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Social Services is the recipient of funds for the LIEAP Program; and


WHEREAS, the Low-Income Energy Assistance Act of 1981 allows up to fifteen (15) percent of the funds to be used for low-cost residential weatherization or other energy-related home repair for low-income households; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order D0121-86, signed on December 8, 1986, designated the Colorado Department of Local Affairs as the responsible agency to administer a low-cost weatherization program and specified that the Department of Local Affairs receive from the Colorado Department of Social Services \$1,464,174 for LIEAP weatherization program and administrative costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby ORDER THAT the Colorado Department of Local Affairs also shall receive from the Colorado Department of Social Services \$146,417 for administrative costs of the weatherization program.
