### EXECUTIVE ORDER REQUIRING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF COLORADO TO APPEAR FOR THE STATE AND, IF WARRANTED, TO PROSECUTE CIVIL ACTIONS

WHEREAS, certain matters have come to the attention of the Governor of the State of Colorado concerning civil lawsuits filed by Joyce McHenry against the State of Colorado and its agents and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has reviewed the merits of these lawsuits and is of the opinion that grounds exist for filing a civil action to enjoin Joyce McHenry from filing any further lawsuits or prosecuting any pending lawsuits against the State of Colorado or its agents and employees without the representation of a licensed attorney; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24-31-101(1), C.R.S. (1986), the Governor of the State of Colorado may grant the authority to the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to prosecute such a civil action on behalf of the State of Colorado;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Richard D. Lamm, Governor of the State of Colorado, do hereby authorize the Attorney General for the State of Colorado to commence any and all civil actions against Joyce McHenry for the purpose of enjoining her from filing or prosecuting any civil action against the State of Colorado, its agents and employees without first obtaining representation of a licensed attorney, or any other further such similar relief as is necessary.
